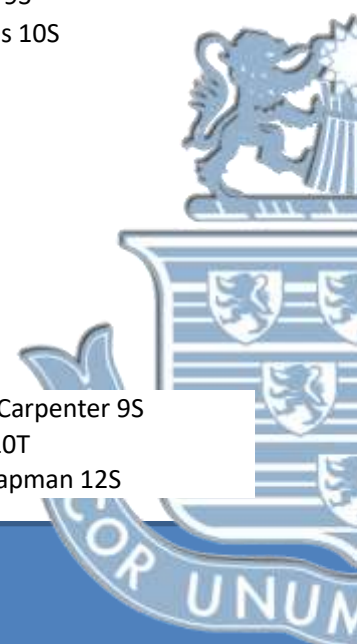


The **Royal British Legion** poppy appeal in school raised **£96.87**, your support makes a real difference.
