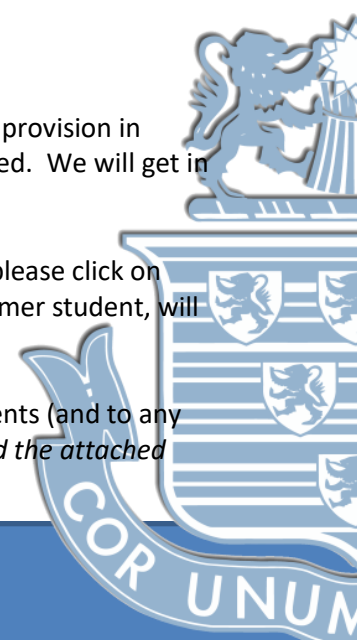




A reminder that the **Years 9 and Year 10 Careers Fair** is on **Thursday 16 July**, with an invitation to Year 11's.
