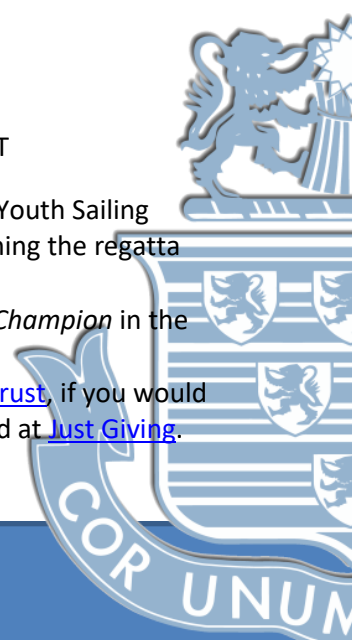

GCE: Thursday 13 August 2026

Results will be available from 8.30 am in the sports hall.

The senior leadership team and head of upper school will be available to assist with any queries or issues.

GCSE: Thursday 20 August 2026

Year 11 results will be available from 8.30 am in the sports hall.

From the start of the 2026 to 2027 academic year, [Free School Meal](#) (FSM) eligibility has been expanded to include all children from households in receipt of Universal Credit regardless of household earnings. Free School Meals are available to pupils in receipt of, or whose parents are in receipt of, one or more of the following benefits:

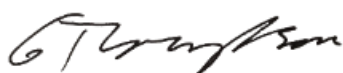
- Universal Credit
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 From September 2026, there will be 2 categories of benefits-based free school meals:
 - **Targeted FSM**, which continues to be based on the existing threshold, covering pupils who are in households in receipt of Universal Credit with annual household earnings of £7,400 or less
 - **Expanded FSM**, a new category covering pupils who do not qualify for targeted FSM, but who are in households receiving Universal Credit

If your child is eligible for Targeted FSM, your school will receive additional funding called [the Pupil Premium grant](#). All children who are either Targeted or Expanded FSM eligible will get a free meal at school.

A reminder to all Year 11 and Year 13 students to drop off **library books** and **locker keys** into the box provided at Reception.

Many of you will be aware that **Mablethorpe** will be receiving £20 million over the next ten years from government funding investment. As a school we have been working with the **Pride in Place** government funding initiative for Mablethorpe. One of the key objectives, at this time, is for young people who live in this area to have their say.
