The Student Senior Leadership Team are delighted to announce that QEGS Colour Run will take place on the afternoon of Monday 20th July for all students who expressed an interest in a recent survey. The event will be held on the school field and promises to be a fun, energetic, and vibrant experience for everyone involved.

There will be an entrance fee of £5.00 per pupil. All proceeds from the event will be donated to the National Autistic Society. Entrance fees can be paid through Parent Pay, or in cash at the school office.

Students who are running must bring the following items with them:

- A **change of clothes** for the colour run – this must include a plain white t-shirt, so the colours show up, shorts and trainers
- **Sunglasses** to help protect their eyes from the powder during the activity.
- A **carrier bag** to place their colourful clothes in after the event.

We recommend that pupils wear clothes they are happy to spoil, as the coloured powder used during the Colour Run may leave permanent marks on some fabrics. They will be required to change back into school uniform after the event to go home, this is mainly to keep the buses nice and clean, so bringing a carrier bag for their colourful clothes is vital!

We have attached an ingredient list for the colour powder to check for any allergens that may affect students' participation, and a consent form to be filled out and returned to the office.

We are looking forward to a fantastic afternoon filled with fun, laughter, and lots of colour, whilst also raising money for a worthwhile cause.
