Sir Walter Lancelot Travers attended Queen Elizabeth's Grammar School from 1888. He founded the Alford Elizabethans' Association to help ex-pupils of the school remain in contact with each other and the school.

Sir Walter's lasting affection for his former school was reflected in his will. After providing for his family and charitable causes, he left the remainder of his estate in trust to support students progressing from the school to university education (including a single gap year). Award amounts are discretionary and depend on the number of applicants each year.
