

Please be aware that there are current concerns regarding young people receiving approx. £160-£400 per month, cash transfer, to review music albums online. One young person was also paid £1000 to purchase a computer. The website address is www.terrabytestudios.co and looks very professional, the young people have no prior experience, relevant qualifications and it is unclear how the money to pay them is generated. The concerns are that this is part of a grooming process for child sexual exploitation through enabling and encouraging contact and relationships with young people which initially may appear legitimate. The Police have been made aware of these concerns. Please inform the school if you are worried that this may have happened to your child and we will support and advise.
