

Connecting Classrooms through Global Learning

Pupils and teachers at QEGS have started an exciting project with other Lincolnshire schools and partners in India on an international Connecting Classrooms through Global Learning project. This programme is organised and funded by the British Council.

The focus is the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (2015-2030), often known as the Global Goals. We are working with our partners in India on Good Health and Wellbeing and Climate Action. We are most closely with Shri Ram Global School, Greater Noida. Before the pandemic there would have been reciprocal visits with teachers spending time in each others' schools, but this is currently impossible, and classes are meeting online.

The teacher in charge of the project in our school is Miss Meakin.

Last term:

- students from 7S did an assembly on mental health which was recorded and shared.
- students from Y8 created food and nutrition posters looking at how to have a healthy diet and why this is important.
- students from 9C designed a garden for the school. They researched what crops to grow and when, they looked at plants to include and garden furniture like benches and picnic tables so make the space enjoyable.
- students from Y10 created presentation on COP26.

All student work has been shared and well received by our Indian partner school. In December some of the students joined a Zoom call with our partner schools in India where they discussed "How green is my school?"



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
