Subject: Introducing the “Stay Safe Days” Programme Tuesday 1 March 2022

The 'Stay Safe Days' programme aims to improve personal safety by making pupils aware of the consequences of their actions on themselves, their families, and the community.

Five subject areas are given by different agencies:

1. Anti-Social Behaviour by Lincolnshire Police
2. Fire Safety by Lincolnshire Fire and Rescue
3. Internet Safety by Lincolnshire Safeguarding Children Partnership
4. Alcohol Awareness by We Are With You
5. Healthy Relationships by Lincolnshire County Council

The programme has had some excellent feedback from pupils because it does not tell them what to do, but gives them the facts and safety tips about the subject and raises awareness about what could happen if they take certain steps.

Some of the information in the sessions is hard hitting, and there are photos and videos which we think are suitable for year 8 pupils, however, we recognise that some pupils may be sensitive to them due to personal experience or circumstances. Therefore, we will be speaking to the school in advance to show them the content and find out if any pupil may be affected.
