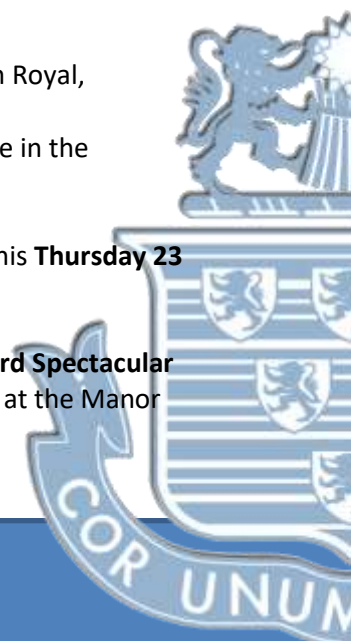
- Florence Jacques 7S competed in a cheer leading competition in Bolton with her team Royal, successfully achieving 1st place as Grand Champion Cheerleaders.


